

Reciprocal Road Charge for foreign-registered cars

From February 15, all foreign-registered cars are required to pay a Reciprocal Road Charge of \$6.40 per entry when they enter Singapore via the Tuas or Woodlands checkpoint.

NOTE: *Vans/light goods vehicles are defined as those having two axles or six wheels or less. All figures are in S\$.

Vehicle Entry Permit (VEP) fees for foreign-registered cars and motorcycles

Foreign-registered cars and motorcycles are required to pay VEP fees for each day the vehicles are kept or used in Singapore. Motorists can drive into Singapore for 10 VEP-free days per calendar year.

Current charges for a foreign car (with IU installed) using the Causeway is
 $\$3.80 + \$2.70 + \$35 = \41.50

NOTE: **During the Singapore mid-year and year-end school holidays, VEP fees will apply from 2am-12pm. All figures are in S\$.

Fixed Electronic Road Pricing (ERP) fee

All foreign-registered car owners who do not have an In-Vehicle Unit (IU) installed must pay a fixed ERP fee of \$5 daily if they use ERP-priced roads during ERP operating hours.
